MINISTRY TEAM IN MOZAMBIQUE FOR CHRISTMAS

Kalibu Ministries sent a team to Mozambique in December to help pastors Jim and Eileen who went to the U.S for Christmas, a well deserved rest, and to make contacts for their "black wood" industry so there was a true need for us to help out there.

In the team there were Pastor Navaya, Mark, Timo and Christopher. At first Timo went to Morrumbala to assist by himself but after 10 days the rest of the team arrived.

Timo was overseeing the workshop and ministering in the church until the reinforcements arrived to help. After the arrival of the rest of the team we went around to preach in Kalibu Kwa Yesu's churches which are numerous. Pastor Navaya with Mark and Timo ministered to people and Timo in particular was able to get some precious field experience regarding preaching and also how to overcome food poisoning in the field without the assistance of medical aid except that of the Lord. In one of the churches there was a demon possessed woman and after Pastor Navaya had prayed for her she got free. Hallelujah! There were many exciting salvations, healings and deliverances as is normally the case when we send teams out into these rural areas. God responds to the preaching of the Gospel with signs and wonders.

The local Pastors were excited to see "azungus" - that is white men - sleep on the floor of the church and eat the same food that they did. It is as Pastor Renato said: "that if they receive you, they also receive your message." You will never be able to reach them with the Gospel of salvation if you offend them. Pastor Renato - originally from Brazil - is one of the faithful missionaries in Mozambique together with Pastors Jim and Eileen. Being a Brazilian he loves to play soccer and because of that and the love that Africans have for soccer it has opened doors for him to minister to young people in the area and even the local radio station has, in the past, given him opportunity to share the Gospel on the air.

Our trip to Mozambique was not just a time of work but there was also time to relax. For example, the team went to the beach near Quelimane and spent Christmas there. The beach stretches for miles and you can sit on the sand early in the mornings and watch the fishing boats come in with their catch after being out all night. You are also able to purchase fresh fish and seafood straight from the nets. It is truly a sight from the New Testament - just as if you are sitting on the shores of Galilee watching as Peter brings in his boat with the nightly catch.

Our mission to Mozambique was altogether good and lasted about five weeks. I'm also sure we were a blessing to the churches. Of course, we had some troubles like couple of flat tires - expected in Africa - but otherwise the Lord kept us safe and blessed.

Our Jesus is wonderful and He rewards those that seek Him and serve Him! (Timo—Bible College Student)

AFRICA FROM AN AFRICAN- AMERICAN WOMAN'S POINT OF VIEW

When I arrived in Malawian I felt like I had flown over 7,000 miles all the way from South Carolina to arrive again in South Carolina. The native South Carolinians and the Malawi people are like one. They are genuine and loving people just like I have always known it as a child born in South Carolina.

I can identify with no electricity, running water, no indoor toilet, going to the woods to cut wood to use for cooking, heating and bathing. I can also identify with being poor. There were so many times when my Mom, alone with 11 children and no food, would bless the empty table that we sat at for dinner, and before dark dinner would show up. It was truly my mother's faith that helped her to raise 11 children, 4 of them with Sickle Cell Anemia. She will always be my hero for her tenacity and great faith and determination. I see my Mom here everyday in the eyes of the women and even the men as they work so hard to survive.

What I knew as poverty was great wealth compared to the poverty of the 21st century Malawians of 2008. The Poverty that I knew in the 1950's & 60's that I experienced in the Phillip's community of Mt. Pleasant South Carolina had some strong similarities of no shoes, nor running water or indoor plumbing and using an out-house..

I have seen so many people from so many countries who have given of their time and even all of their worldly possessions to come and help the Malawian people here, but I see only a handful of African Americans in Malawi. I would like to encourage more African Americans to come and be here for more than 2 weeks to 1 month to stay and help encourage and empower the people.

The Malawian women are for the most part laid back and unmotivated. Since the Women's group has been meeting they want to purchase a mini bus to do ministry in the village and to have transportation in general. They have embarked upon their first fund raiser which include a native treat called "samosa" this is a pastry filled with a very tasty beef mixture and cupcakes. They will need to sell lots of samosas to raise about 1 million kwacha to buy a used minibus in good condition. Right now 1 US dollar is about K148 kwachas.

So much is needed here. The month of May starts the winter months and it lasts until September, many have no winter clothes, shoes, coats, blankets, hats or gloves.

The people have faith that God will provide for them. Many are encouraged that God has not forgotten them.

On the front page of the daily newspaper the Malawi president said, "God Is On My Side". He stated this to express that God will help him do the work of caring for the Malawian people.

Will you join your faith and prayers with that of the Malawian people and help them in their day to day life with your support.

There is so much that you can do. Ask God to show you what He wants to do to help and then obey that without wavering or doubting.

Be a partner on a mission and give to support God's work. It is important to remember that the work is always about God and not about us. Give your prayers, resources and financial support and be blessed. (Rosetta Swinton SC)

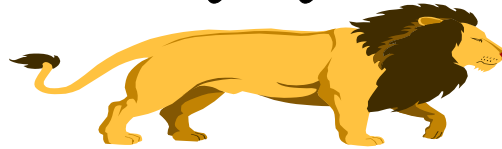
