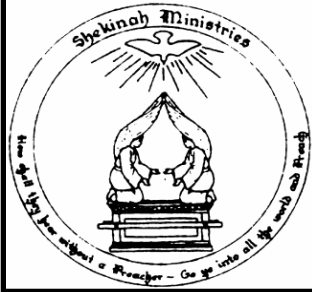

Florida Court Sets Atheist Holy Day

This gives a whole new scope for those students who are just not academically inclined but are wonderful with their hands.

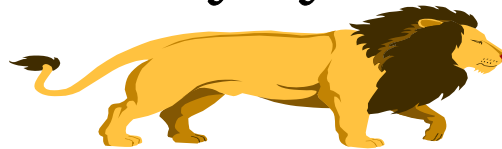
