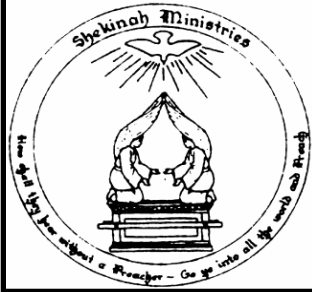

Beloved Partners & Friends

It has been brought home yet again, the need as well as the power that exists in repentance. The only true freedom we have as believers is in repentance. All too often, it is easy for us to live with our status quo and not even realize that we have slowly and systematically slipped into bondage whether of thinking or behavior that soon becomes a life style. It is human nature to always justify and excuse and reason away our faults and failures instead of simply acknowledging, repenting and becoming free. We seldom stop to ask the Lord if He is satisfied with us and often excuse our attitudes and behavior with the oft quoted phrase, "I'm doing nothing wrong." Yet, when we measure up to the mirror of God's Word, we find ourselves sadly lacking in thought and word and deed. Sin for the believer is not about doing wrong but about the SELF nature that lurks deep within. People for instance who always want "my space" are all about self. Now, this is fine as far as humanistic philosophy is concerned but for a deeper walk with the Lord this is simply not good enough. Self requires repentance to put ourselves back on track. The first and most important aspect in repentance is to recognize that I am OUT OF ORDER with the Lord. It is often difficult to recognize this if I am set on a path that I have mapped out and refuse to listen to any opposing voice that speaks into my life. Many times, we think we are SO RIGHT? Mr. or Mrs. RIGHT; Mr. or Mrs. ALWAYS RIGHT; and, Mr. or Mrs. ETERNALLY RIGHT! It is apparent to everyone but me that I am headed for disaster and will not listen or take advice. Now, as a pioneer trail blazer, I know very well that there are times when everyone opposes what the Lord has clearly directed to be done and one needs to press on resolutely. I am not speaking about this type of situation. Here, the condition is that a person is walking a mature, consistent and spiritual

always the fruit under such circumstances. Secondly, when I do acknowledge from the Word, the Spirit or concerned advice of friends that I am out of order, I need to repent. Repentance must consider that I have offended God firstly and perhaps also another person. Sin is missing the target and the real target for all of us is the heartbeat of Almighty God. It must be my passion and desire to always tabernacle in the heartbeat of God and if I am not there to find out the reason and repent. Self is always the trouble and stands between me and the Lord. David said, "Against thee and thee only have I sinned..." If I am not where I was with the Lord yesterday, I need to take serious stock of my life and repent. After acknowledging, I need to openly speak to the Lord. All too often we are led to believe that making a mental assent is sufficient. BUT, the Word is clear in stating, "If I CONFESS my sin..." Confession is not optional to the believer and confession means opening my mouth and using my tongue to speak aloud to the Lord. It does the soul good to regularly take stock with the Lord. You might stop and do it right now and allow the blessed Holy Spirit to speak to you and perhaps show you where there needs to be some repentance. It is CONVERSATION with the Lord and must be open and audibly verbal. It does good to get alone in a secret place and pour out your heart to the Lord and I mean, really pour out your heart to Him in Godly sorrow until tears flow. Repentance means a 180 degree turn from the direction in which you were going. This is the third aspect about true repentance. I cannot say, "Sorry," and continue as I had been going. Sorry means an about turn and begins with seeing myself from God's point of view and not my own. It is time to see that SELF in all its forms is a brazen, rebellious affront to God of which we all need to repent. The final aspect of repentance is to enjoy freedom, joy and peace that must come when true repentance is complete and the past is covered in the blood of Jesus. This is INSTANT! It is not something that we must conjure, build or receive over time. God is a NOW God and He instantly forgives the moment that true repentance is completed. Any distance that might have been immediately disappears and I am at peace with the Lord because the Lord is at peace with me. The power of repentance must never be under-

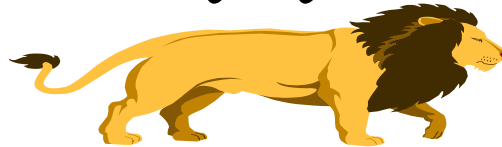
SCHOOL BUS FOR MALAWI
