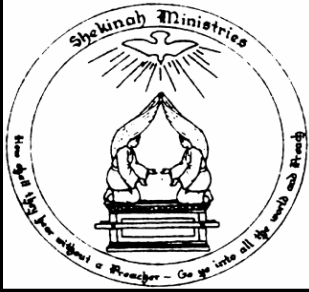

Beloved Partners & Friends

I am sitting on a warm train travelling through freezing Finland having just finished a leadership conference. I ended up just wondering what on earth the Church is coming to when the best of young believers are so hung up about life that they can barely function in life let alone being the dynamic testimony that the Lord would have them to be. I was impressed during this conference as I listened to so many issues from so many people at just how fragmented the church has become. We have majored on minor issues and lost sight of our true purpose and He is JESUS. The other critical and very clear problem is the total lack of DISCIPLINE. One cannot make a disciple unless there is discipline and I am not talking about cultural differences but about straight Biblical demands. The issue between Paul and Barnabas over John Mark is a clear example of the lack of personal discipline that ended up creating a major rift between two leading apostles. Thank you to the Lord that John Mark obviously repented and became one of the most faithful workers of Paul to the degree that Paul declared him to be “profitable” to the ministry. But, what price was paid? As a result of the altercation and because of one selfish, ill-disciplined young man who deserted Paul in the time of need, perhaps the loss of Asia Minor to the Gospel. The other major lack in the body of Christ is the lack of vision. Where there is no vision, the people perish. The perishing is both called and they to whom the individual is called.

We need a new generation of passionate visionaries who are willing to be disciplined so that they may be disciplined. We need a new generation of young men and women, who, forsaking all will follow Jesus even to a real cross if necessary. This endeavor requires, nay, demands enormous investment which is also long term investment. Very few people today are prepared,

let alone willing to look and invest long term because it means that there will be no tangible benefit to self. It is for this reason that most of the Church is not KINGDOM MINDED. Most leaders today are not building HIS KINGDOM but all that we build that is of self and all of our kingdoms will pass away no matter how good they look. The need has become so frighteningly enormous that we cannot wait any longer. The Holy Spirit is really impressing upon me the urgent need to raise up the INTERNATIONAL BIBLE COLLEGE in Malawi that will operate under the order and government of almighty God. This means that there will be true BIBLICAL DISCIPLINE. We have already embarked upon building entire housing units in Tampere, Finland. These units or modules will consist of six entirely self contained rooms that will fit into a forty foot container and will be shipped to Africa and assembled there. This is exciting and timely and we need YOUR SUPPORT to accomplish this vision speedily. We already have the land, water and power in Malawi. Now, with this great building vision by Jouni Rantanen, we will be able to achieve this vision in the shortest period of time. We are asking you to really support this timely effort because the hour is urgent and we need to send out disciplined disciples who will be a new wave of mighty firebrands for the Twenty First Century. How else will the Church stand up to radical Islam? How else will that great torch that was lighted nearly two thousand years ago continue to burn brightly? It is not up to the Chinese and Africans and Indians to keep the fires burning brightly. It is up to all of us. It is long overdue that young western believers found fresh purpose and are both challenged and equipped to be ready to give everything for Christ in this generation and to prepare the next for the same. Whether financially, in true intercession or by giving expert workmanship we will again, be able to build something that will IMPACT THE NATIONS for Christ. In two years we will have fifty units completed and shipped to Malawi. The needs are great but our God is even greater. He has never failed before and like the Academy, this vision will come to pass. We want you to be a powerful part of this next great move in Kalibu/Shekinah for what the Lord has purposed. Years of investment into our lives and ministry have been prepa-

ration for this next stage of growth. I am thrilled and excited about what is going to happen. This will be a dynamic Bible school where the students will be focused on prayer, Bible study and ministry 24/7 without any interruptions. Fasting, prayer, sacrifice, death to self and a huge dose of love will be the hallmarks of this Bible College where we will offer universally recognized diplomas and degrees. But, this is not about theology but the true living reality of Christ in power.

EXTENSION OF THE MALAWI WORK

My introduction to Michael Howard was not face to face but instead I (Mark Cronin) met him through "Tales of an African Intercessor" his book. I was profoundly stirred by his writings and work especially the bible school in Sudan. On later discovery I found out that he was running a bible school in Malawi. I was accepted and arrived in April 2007 at Chileka International Airport where I was welcomed by 40° C!!! (Unheard of to an Englishman except on a thermometer...) To describe my 2 ½ years attending classes and doing practicals here would be understated if I was to say it has been a reformation because my life has been utterly transformed! Africa has been a furnace (literally) but God has fully sustained me and moulded me here under the remarkable tuition and guidance of Michael Howard, Frank Vandyck, Paisley Mavatula and Christopher Navaya. "Perfect love casts out all fear" and after having been under the anointed fivefold ministry of Michael Howard I truly have experienced "perfect love." The need for true Apostles in today's Church is inestimable!



I (Maria Salmela) was invited to visit Malawi by Pastor Michael in 2006. Those 2 months changed my life! At that time I had been working in Sweden as a nurse and had been frustrated for a long time. I returned to my work but couldn't get Africa off of my mind. I was then offered to come back to Malawi as a school nurse at Kalibu Academy. Therefore in January 2008 I returned to run the school clinic. I was not bold enough yet to commit myself completely my plan was to return after 1 year back to my old life. As the year drew to an end I was becoming more and more anxious about leaving the mission field. Just before I was to leave

my mother called me from Finland and explained to me how she had dedicated me to God's work on the mission field as a baby. That explained it! By God's amazing grace He led Mark and me together. We got engaged in June 2009 and are getting married in Finland December 12th 2009. On our return to Malawi in 2010 we will be pioneering a new missionary endeavour here to the Muslims under Kalibu Ministries. The goal is to inspire our local Churches to take on the burden of Muslims in this nation and beyond. We will be starting a new centre in Nkhotakota (where David Livingstone first came into contact with the slave trade) which will include a bible school, pastor training and will be the headquarters of this new venture. We will supervise the training and equipping of a vast area of Kalibu's Churches in Malawi reporting to the main base in Blantyre. The work here is huge and always growing because God is continuously moving here. The "Great Commission" is a command to all of us. Let's make sure we pursue it even though to follow the Lord Jesus Christ means the Cross! There is about 1.4 billion Muslims in the world today this fact cannot be ignored!



Mark and Maria we pray all blessings upon you as you join together in this adventure with the Lord. May He guide, direct and protect—may He be your source, healer and provider. Pastors Michael, Roz, Paisley and the Shekinah/Kalibu/Out of Africa teams.

FIELD TRIP BY ACADEMY STUDENTS



As part of their studies this term Form Four students had an education visit to Cape Maclear in Mangochi. Cape Maclear was chosen because it is a good place where students can study two important components of their Geography curriculum, tourism and coastal processes. Both trips were a great success and very beneficial. Students learnt that certain species of fish and other animals are protected in this Park. They also had the opportunity to see different species of Mbuna fish which are only found in Lake Malawi and no where else in the world. They visited one of the Islands in the Park which is an historical site—the grave yard for some of the missionaries who traveled with Dr David Livingstone.

Besides the tourism students had the opportunity to study sea waves: how waves are formed, parts of the wave and wave processes. Among the action of waves, students studied how waves deposit the material they carry in some areas and how they erode the coast in other areas. Further more, students studied the movement of material along the coast (long-shore drift), deposition landforms such as the beach and erosion landforms such as caves, wave-cut platforms, stack and stamps.

Apart from academic studies students also had the opportunity to ride a boat to one of the islands, swim and relax. The trip also provided a good platform for students to learn to be responsible when far away from home and school. It was very encouraging to see them behaving very well on both trips.

We are praying hard so that God can change their hearts. Some of the army like the word of God because they have seen its fruits and have tested it and they have seen how God works miracles through us to the people. They have seen the sick healed when we have prayed in the name of Jesus and many women who were infertile are now having babies after we prayed. Praise Jesus. Many have been delivered and we burned many small gods.

We have not forgotten you especially our supporters. God bought us with His blood and we become one family.

Please mom pass our sincere greetings to Pastor Mike and all and may the Lord be praised.

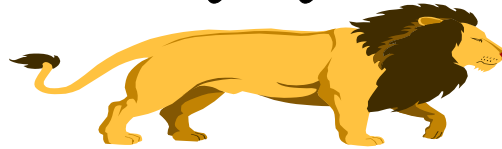
