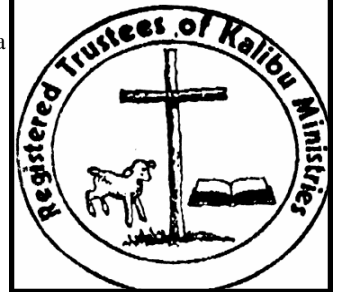

Beloved Partners & Friends

I am sharing again about the Kingdom of Heaven. If there is any greater theme that Jesus came to bring to us then I am yet to find it. He came preaching the all-embracing message of the Kingdom. We hear so little – or none at all – of this most dynamic and powerful of subjects. The message of the Kingdom is a message of how to live kingdom life and authority NOW! Of course, it requires dying to self and LIVING the message of the cross. What does it mean to take up the cross and follow Christ? It is a negation of all the instincts of self and self-preservation given to us by the Lord who then asks us to lay them aside and follow Him. The law of sowing and reaping is a powerful law of the Kingdom. The Lord NEVER requires us to give up anything that He does not then multiply back to us in the here and now, but it requires seeing that principle and then believing it in order to victoriously live it. The Holy Spirit demands super obedience as He leads us to submission to Christ. Most believers are still living by the dictates of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. It is all about what looks and tastes good rather than what actually is good for me. The fruit of the Tree of Life must have had no sensual appeal, for Adam and Eve were free to eat of it but they did not neither seemed they to have any desire for that fruit.

The Kingdom is all about the principles of the Kingdom of Heaven lived out on this planet in our current lives. Those principles do not look good to our fleshly dictates for they require DEATH but out of death comes life. How many believers have paid tithes for years and years but have never really given and certainly never invested in the Kingdom? How many believers will not forgive and CHOOSE to live with bitterness, jealousy and anger because to yield means to lose? How many believers have lived

isolated, selfish lives and never concerned themselves with their neighbors? How many believers have no concern for the lost and dying of the nations? Perhaps the greatest test of whether I am truly KINGDOM is if I really care about the lost and the nations. In our natural state we are utterly selfish and brutish and cannot have a love for the lost. If, dear friend, you have no burden for the lost then you are not kingdom minded even though you are a blood-bought saint.

There is growing talk today about Kingdom Community. Is this just another great sounding religious term that has no practical validity? There can never be kingdom community until and unless we practice exactly what the Holy Spirit demands as presented in the Book of Acts. The foundation of true kingdom community is the apostles' doctrine, communion, fellowship and prayer all of which, of course, are founded on love. Without these ingredients, there will never be any kind of kingdom community. The focus has to be Christ, not out of some legalistic religious perspective, but out of passion and love for Him. If people have no idea about the Kingdom however shall they live its principles? I am not suggesting that everybody moves into a commune. That is another corrupt teaching that was prevalent in the 1980s and 1990s as believers sold up their homes and moved into Christian communities that soon became controlling cults rather than Kingdom. "They ate their meat from house to house..." as the Spirit moved mightily amongst them. Yet, in the midst of such outpourings, flesh still rose up and hijacked what the Lord was doing. Why? Because like the believing church of today, the early church knew little to nothing about Kingdom principles let alone being willing to live them.

There is going to be a visitation of God upon this earth that will outstrip the loftiest and most noble ideas that anyone has on revival. The glory of the Lord is going to cover the earth and all men will see the demonstration of His glorious power so that nobody will have any excuse when Jesus returns. No matter the euphoria of the outpouring,

May this stir us to change, to be more like Him in order to reach out to the multitudes.

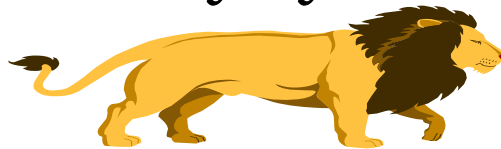
